

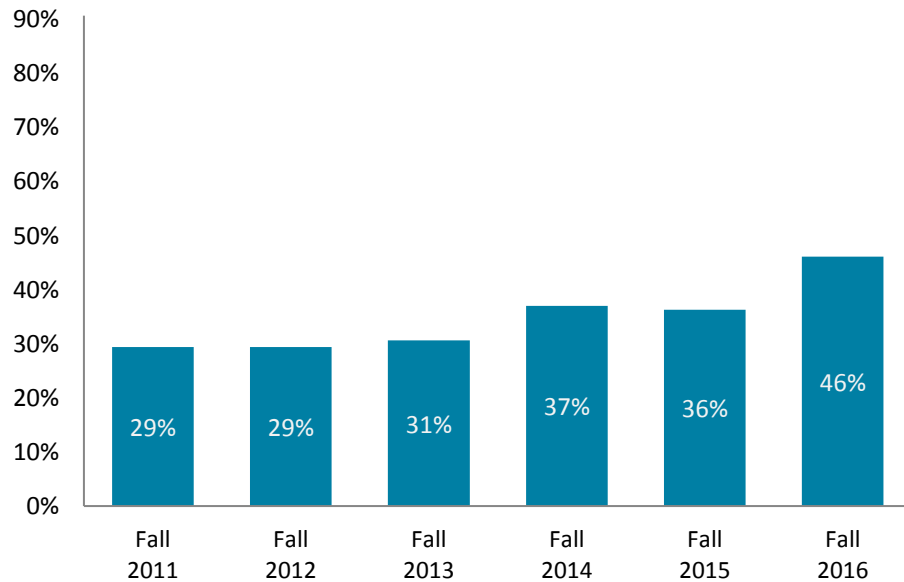

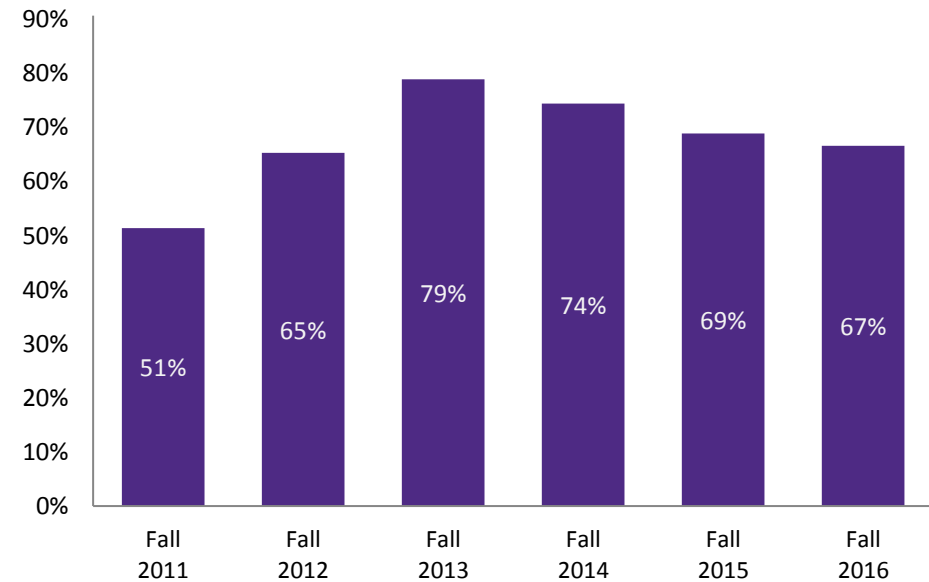

**Selectivity Average = 33%**

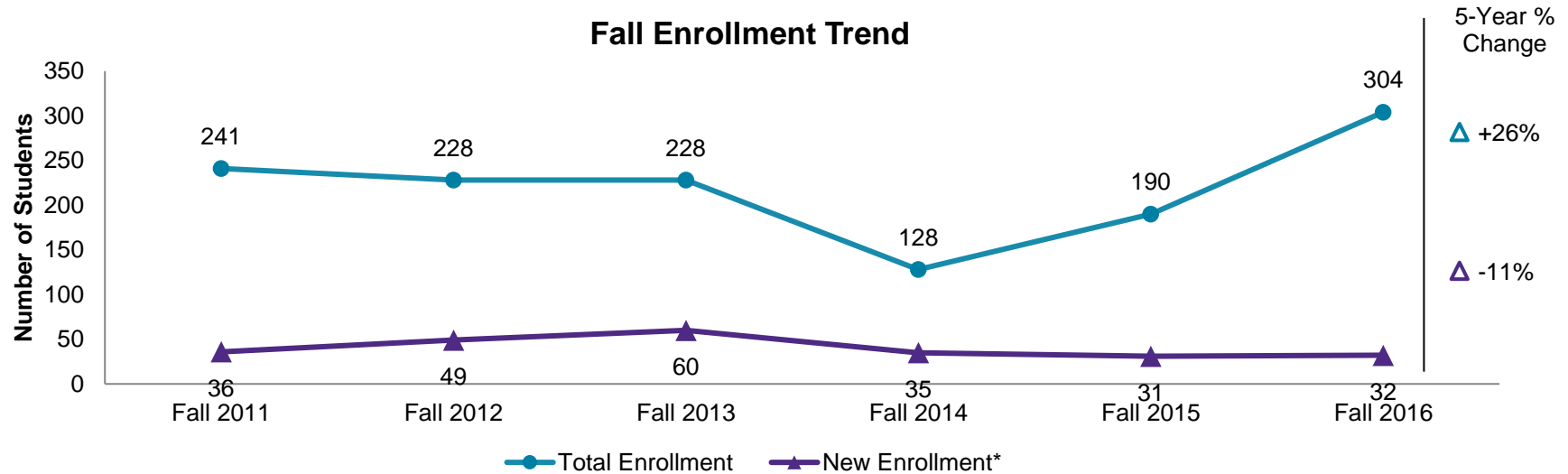
**Yield
