

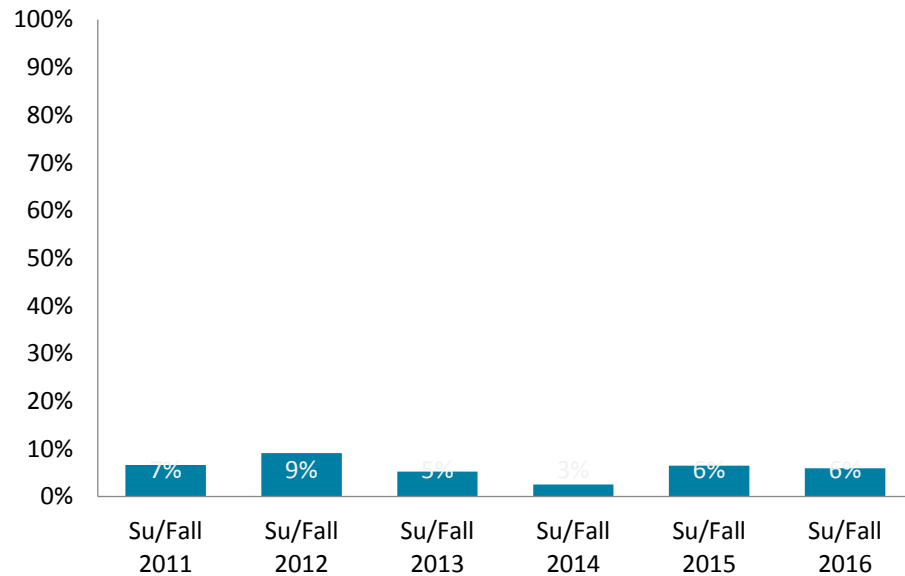

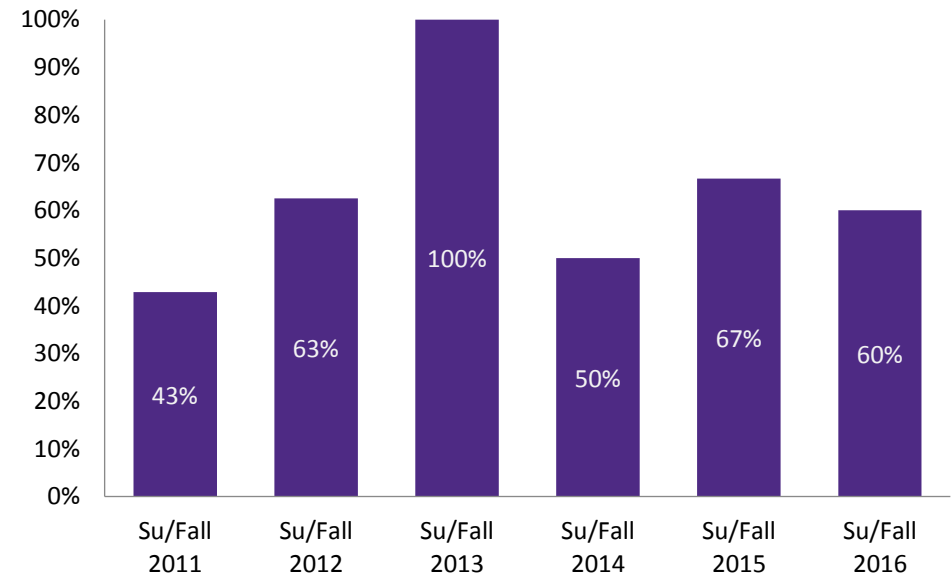

Selectivity Average = 6%

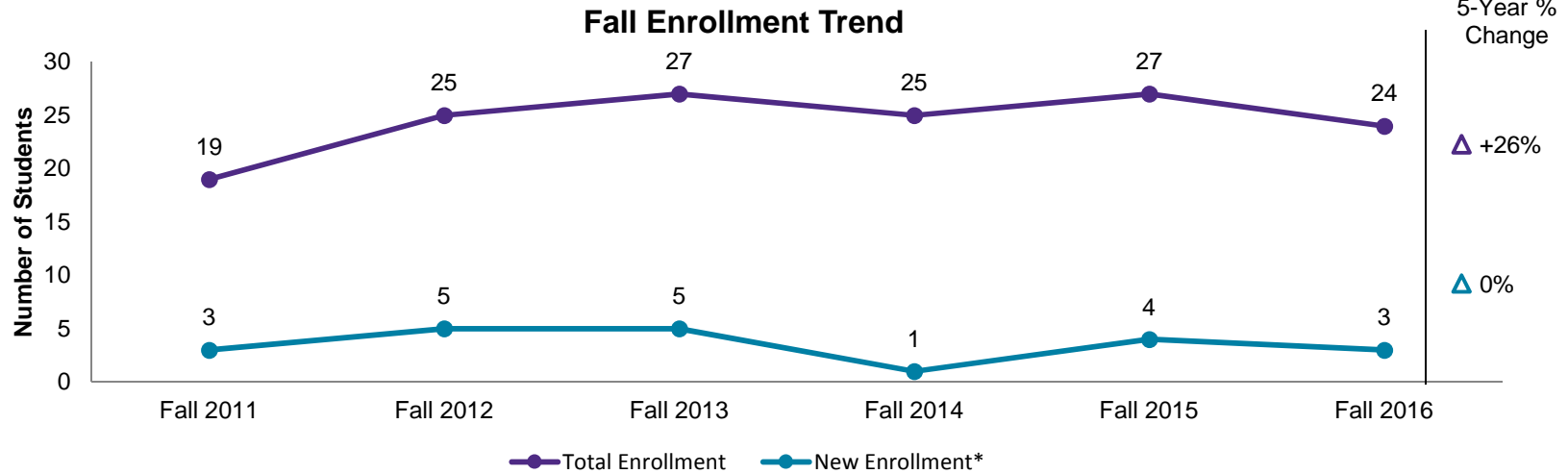
**Yield
