

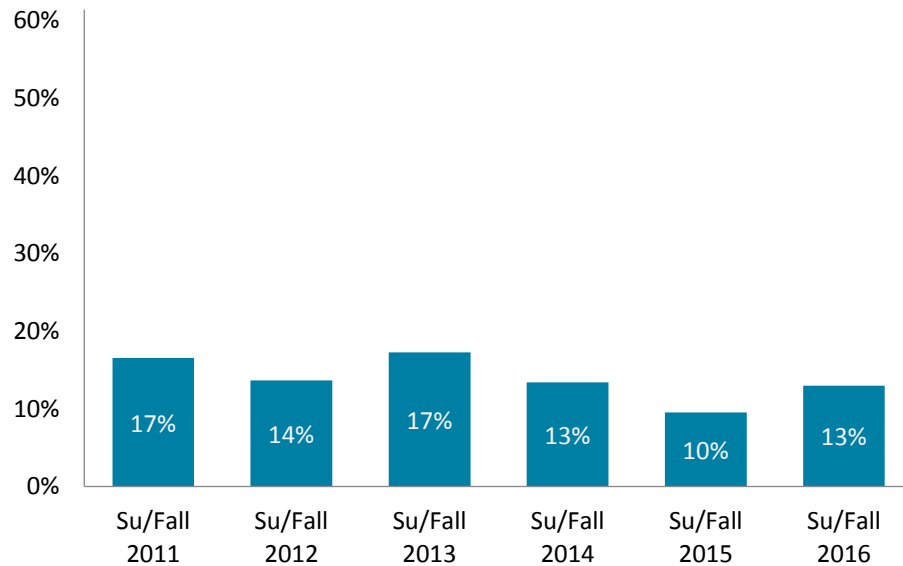

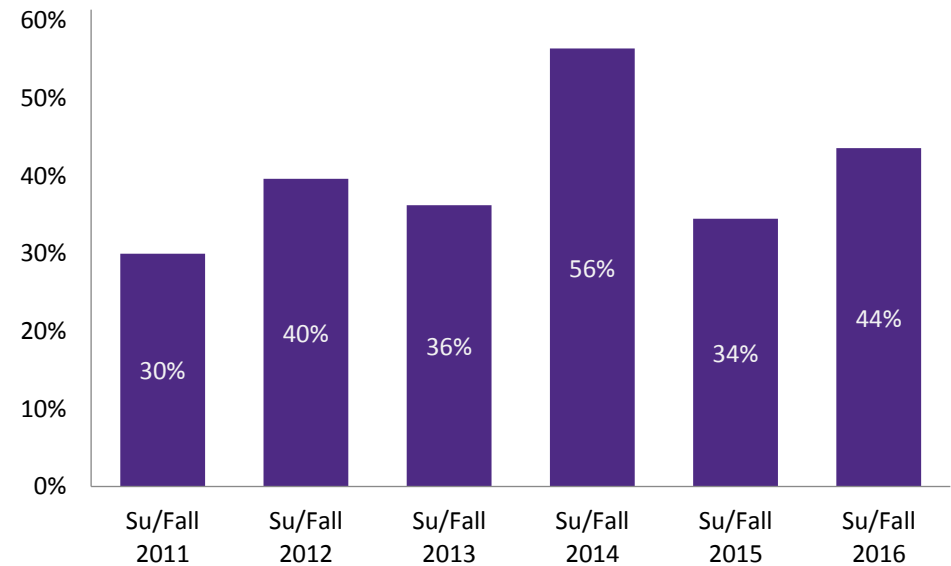

**Selectivity Average = 14%**

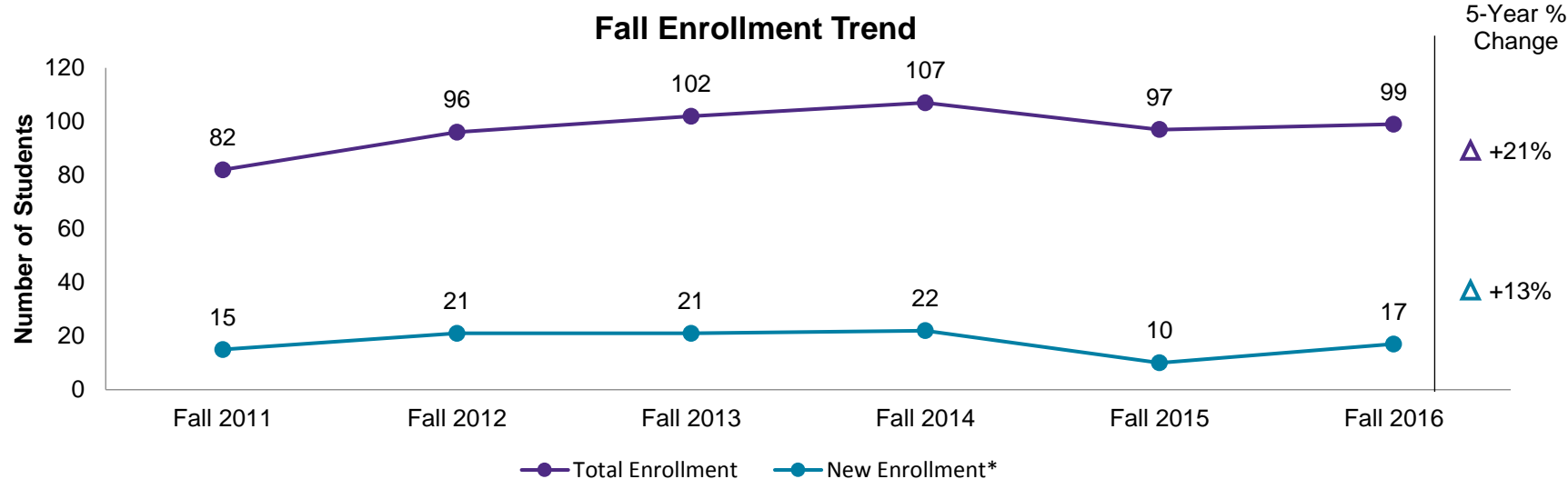
**Yield
