

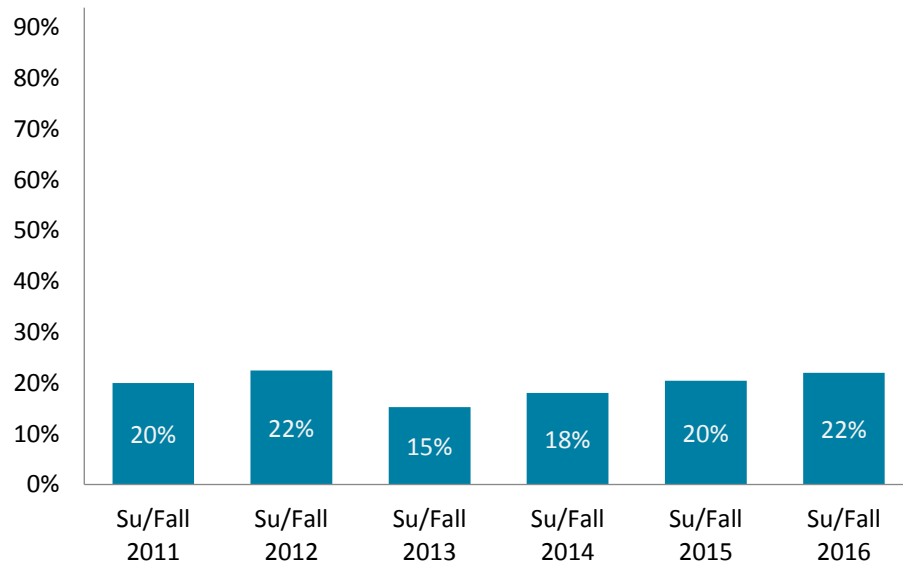

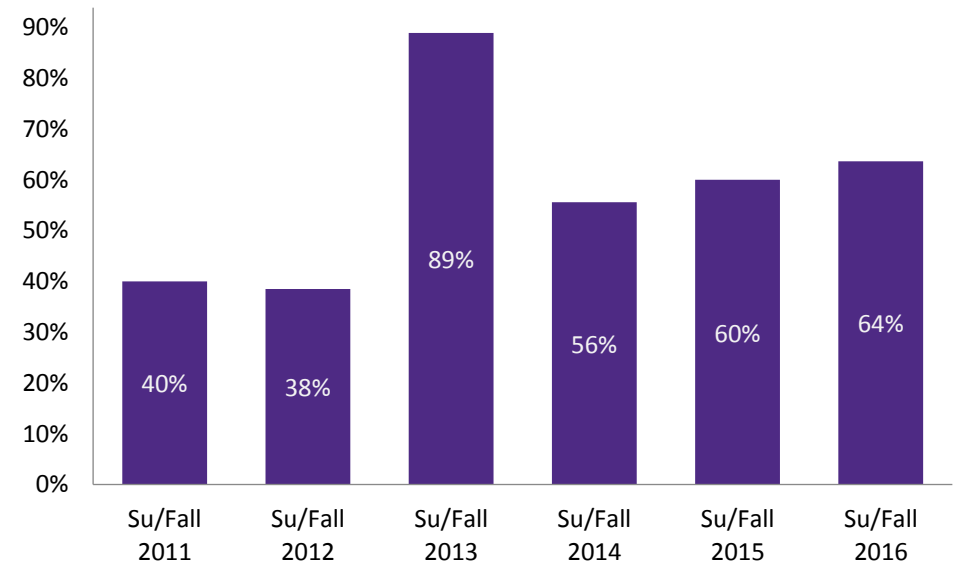

Selectivity Average = 20%

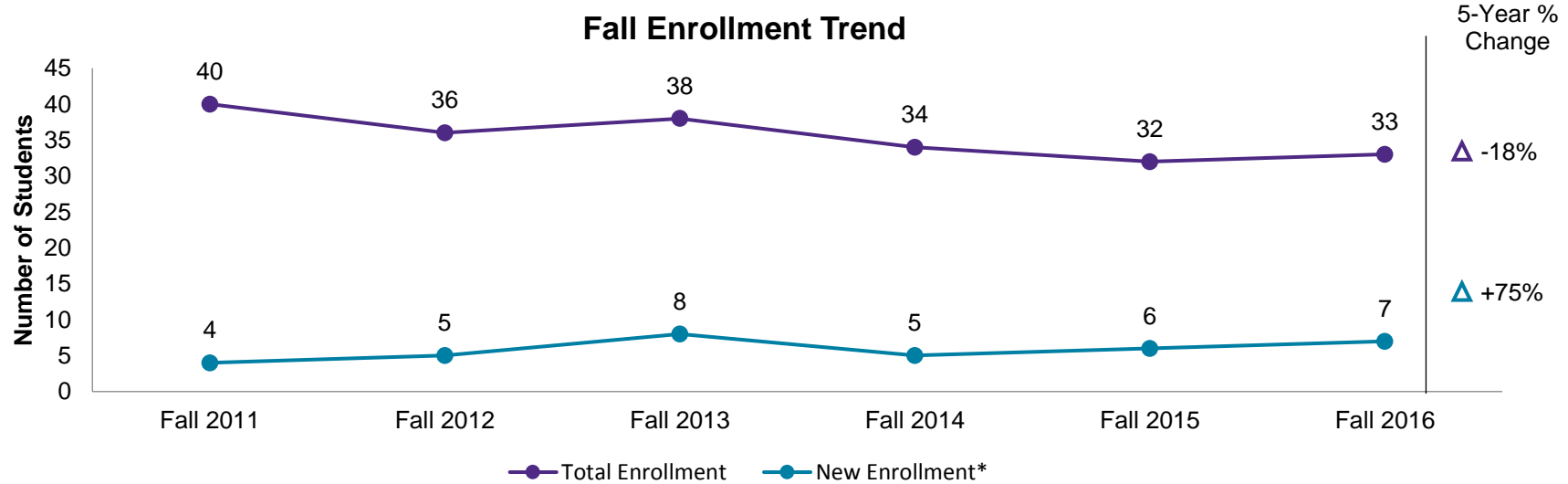
**Yield
