

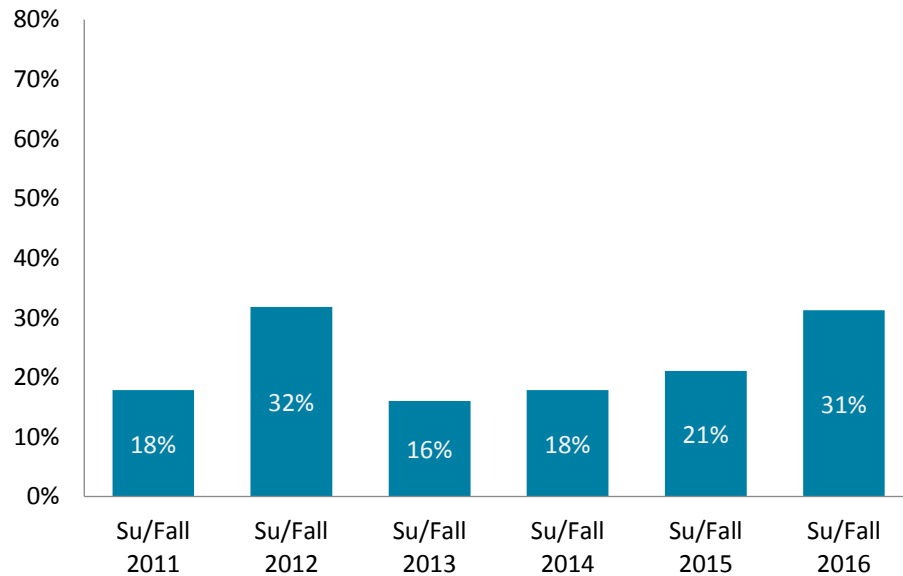

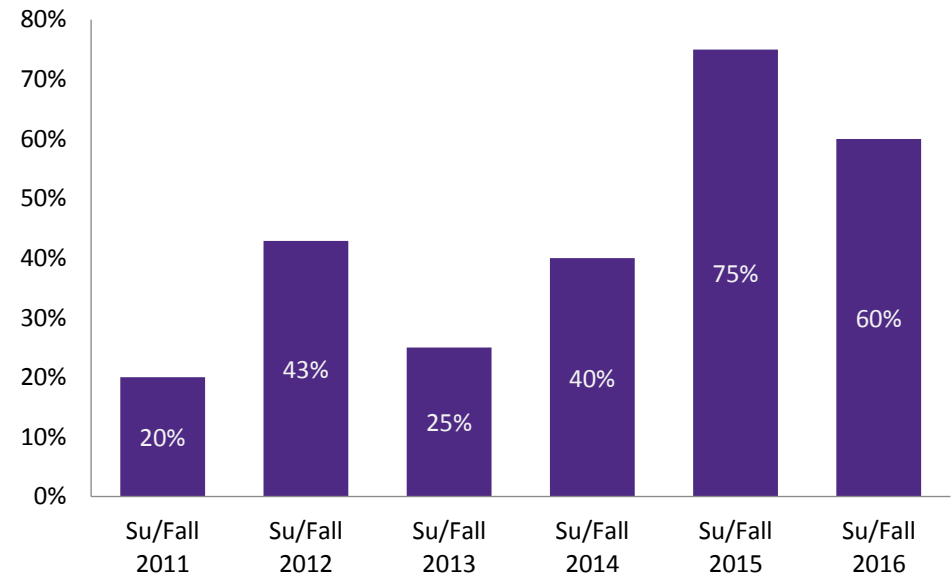

Selectivity Average = 22%

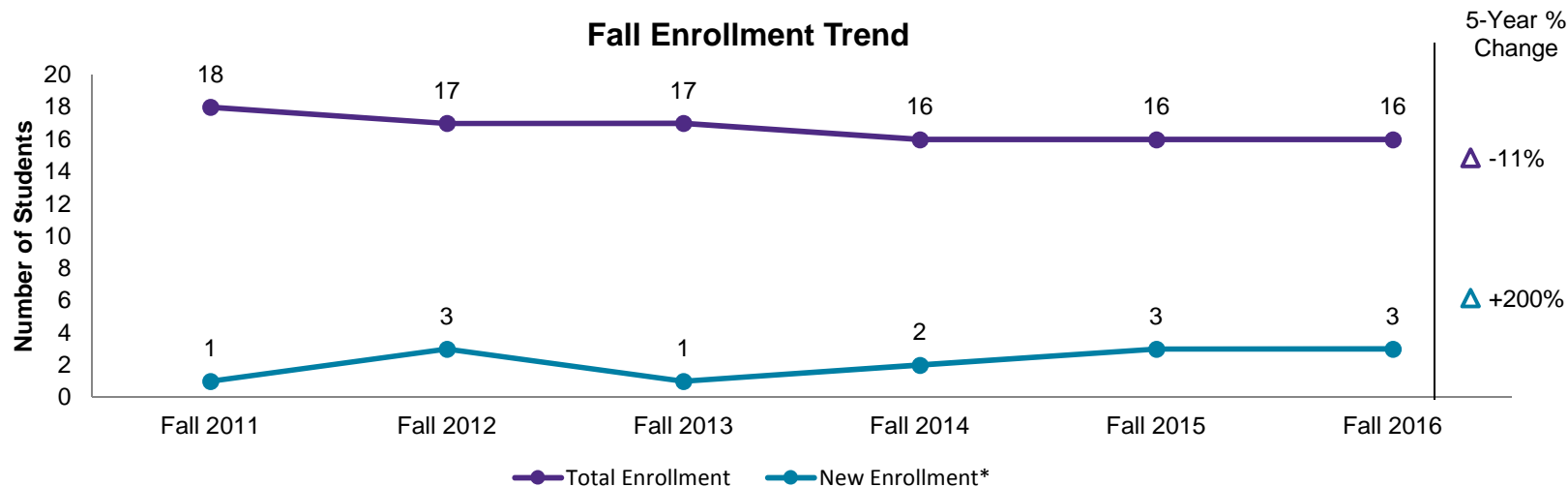
**Yield
