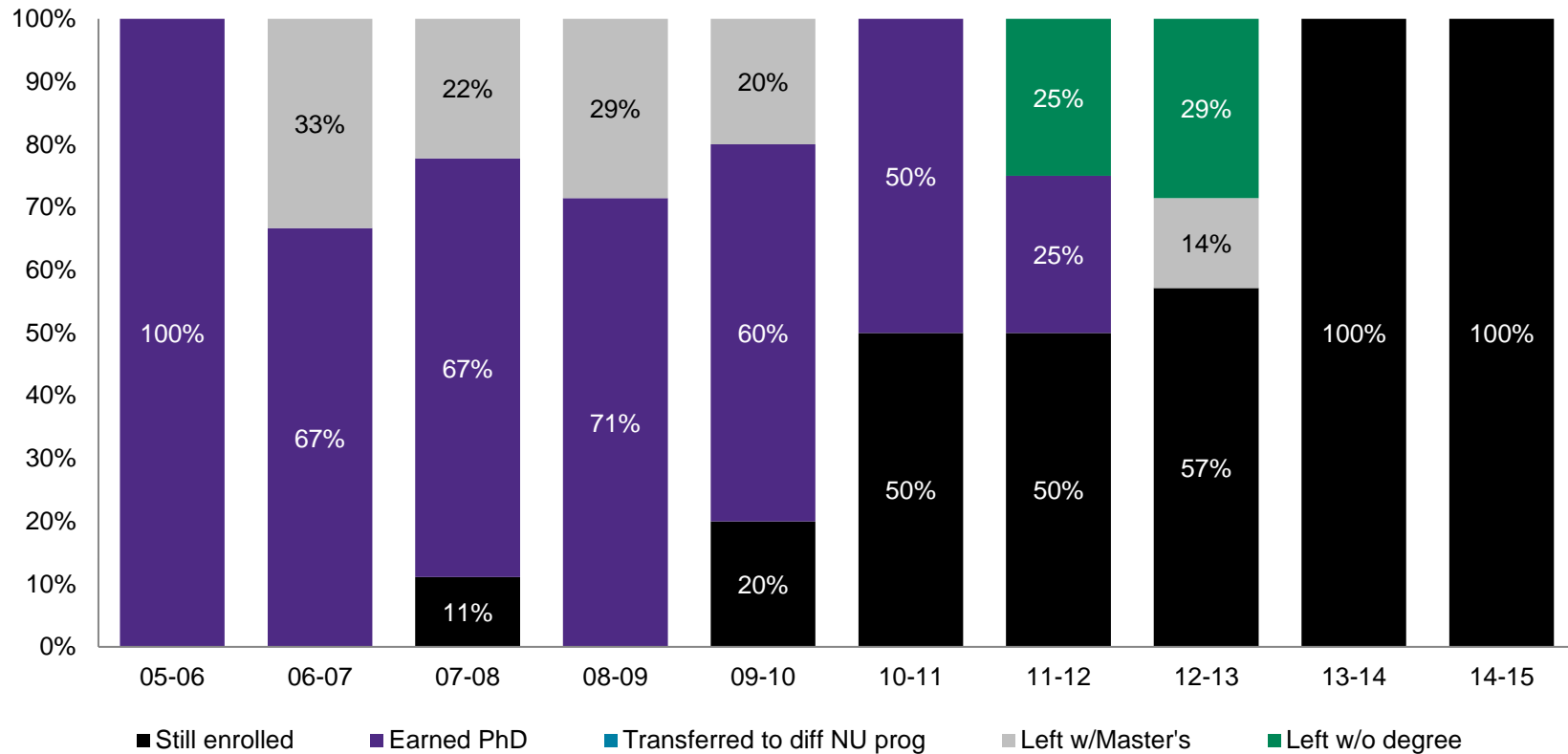

PhD program in Media, Technology and Society was created in fall of 2004

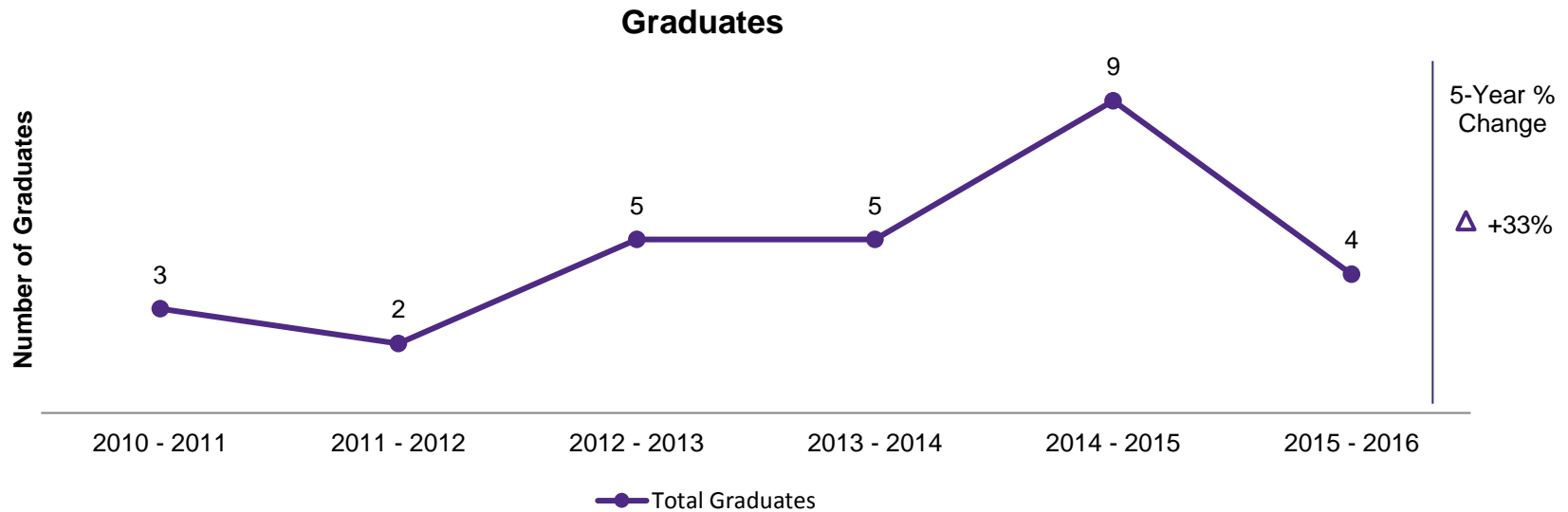
