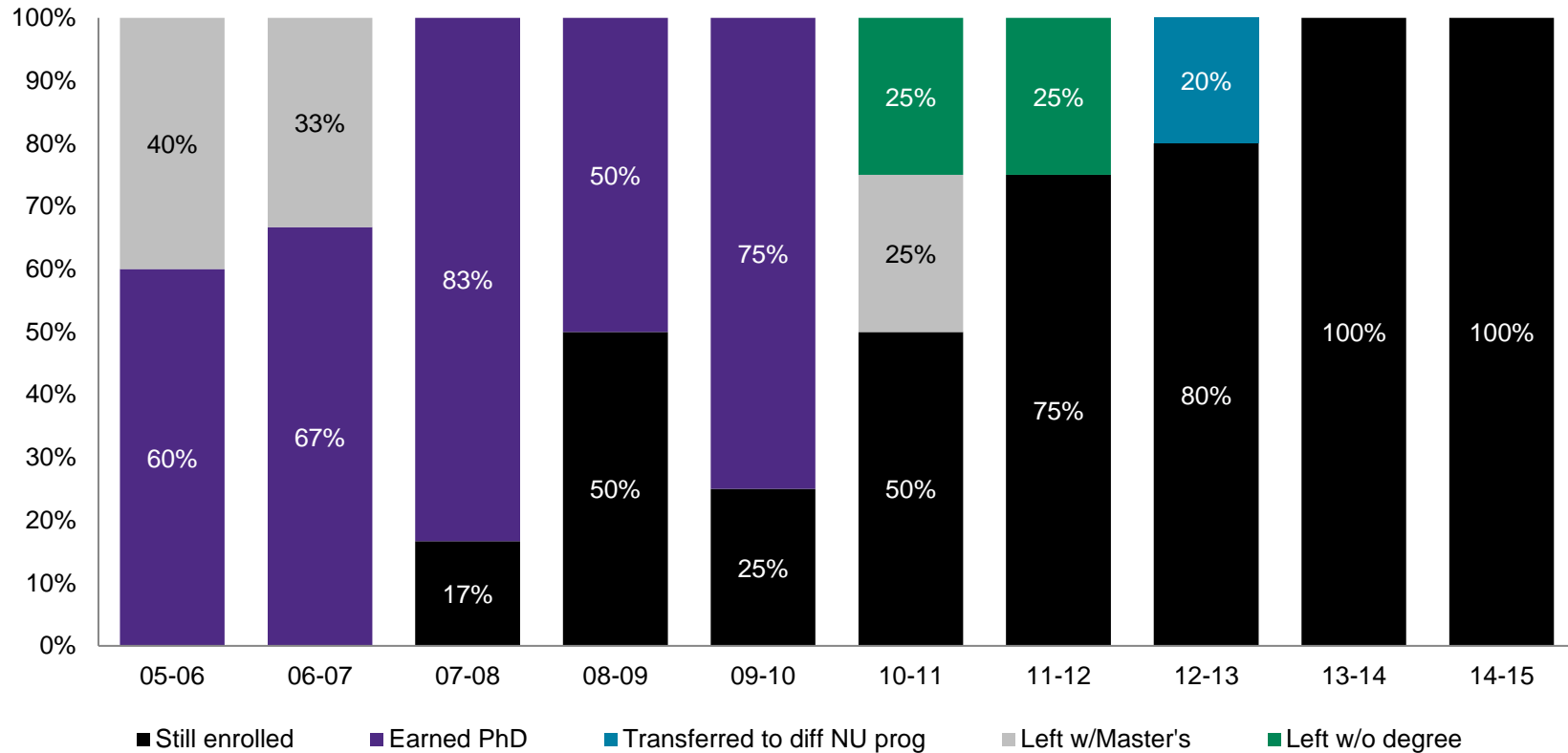


# Religion Program Profile

 Applications for the PhD program in Religion were not accepted from 1998 – 2003.

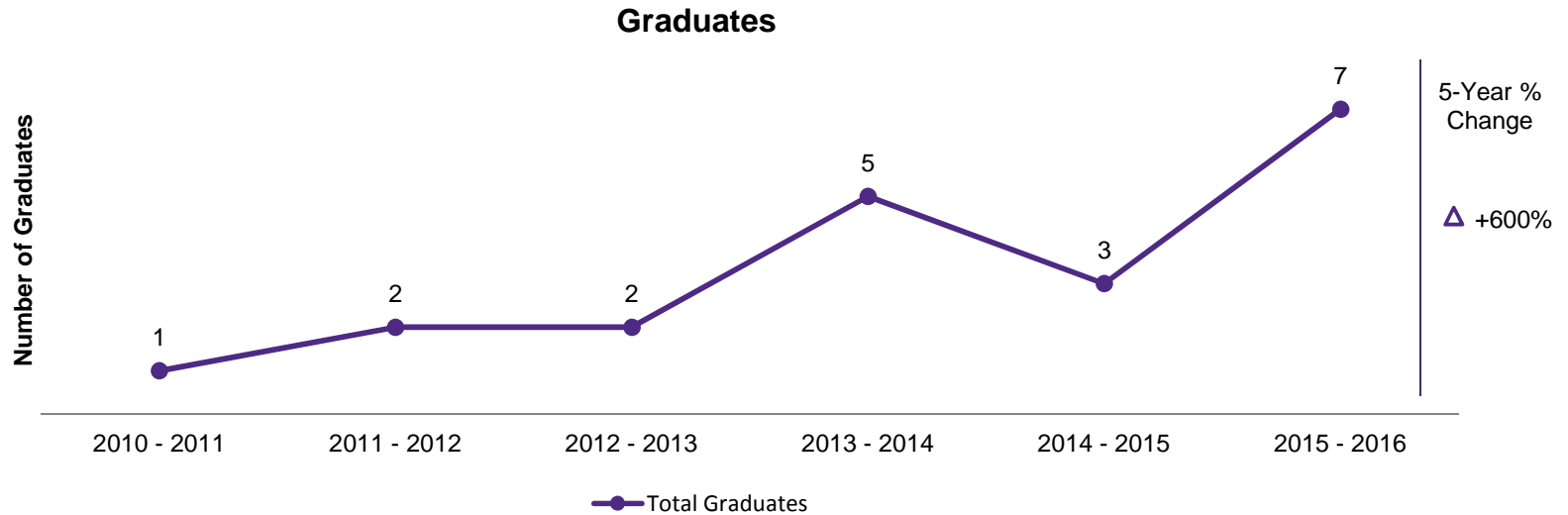
